- Programmes that have been in place or are still running
- Data to show up take on the programmes

4. Update on Local Growth Programme

James Fitzgerald and Steve Futter provided an update on the Local Growth Deal (LGD) and the Getting Building Fund (GBF).

The paper was taken as read and the LGD funding by scheme was highlighted

Questions were received from members on the North Whiteley scheme, M27 Junction 10 scheme and Covid-19 loan fund.

The GBF funding by scheme was highlighted.

Questions were taken on the HIWWT Nutrient Mitigation programme progress. Areas in the paper were highlighted including Local Growth Deal tail projects, an overview of the annual process reviews which have been extended to all projects with some seeking variation requests due to construction delays brought on by Covid-19. Programme updates on the Isle of Wight and New Forest Rural SME Funds overseen by Natural Enterprise were provided. Crowdfunder SME Support Programme was introduced in the early stages of lockdown and saw a very positive response by local businesses. Questions were taken on successor funds to the Local Growth Deal. Solent Growth Forum Members: Noted latest position of the Local Growth Deal and Getting Building Funds as set out in appendices A and B respectively. **Noted** the update in relation to the LGD tail and the ongoing GBF projects as set out in paragraphs 4.1 and 5. **Noted** the updates provided in relation to progress on the Local Growth Deal and Getting Building Fund programmes, including the Annual Progress Reviews. **Noted** the updates provided in relation to the Rural SME and Crowdfunder programmes. Overview of Solent LEP Assurance process The paper was taken as read and Richard Jones gave an overview of the Solent LEP Assurance process. Paul Somerset provided an update on the Solent LEP Audit process, the Annual Opinion for 2020/21 and the Annual Audit Plan for 2021/22. Questions were taken on the actions arising out of audits completed. Once feedback on audits is received, learning points are taken on board to improve internal controls going forward. Next steps and actions are undertaken and an activity plan that is overseen by the Funding, Finance and Performance Manager Group (FFPMG) has been established.
